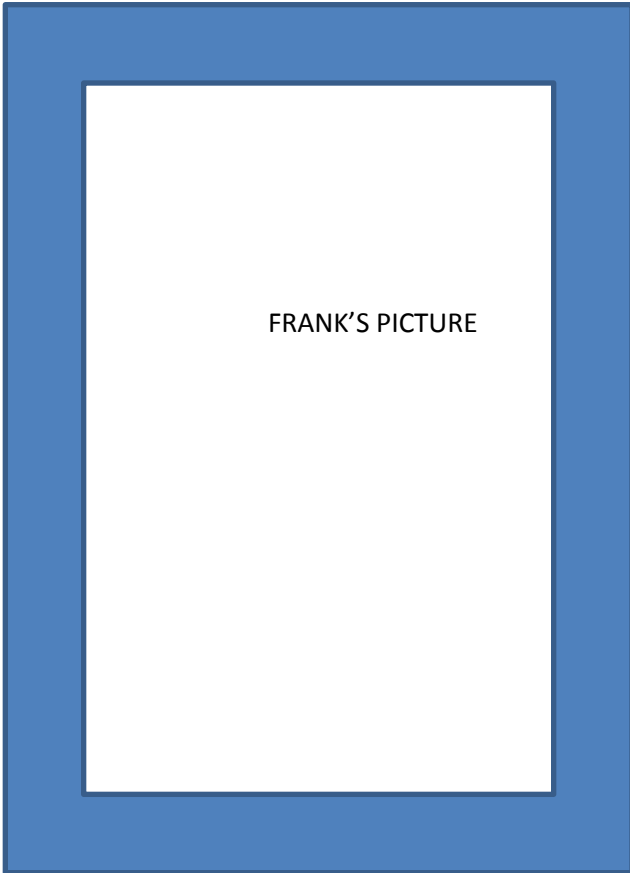


FRANK G. GIUNTA
